

ADAPTIVE BEHAVIORS

Adaptive behaviors are the life skills that each person develops as they grow. The specific life skills developed depends on the chronological age of the individual.

TYPES

- **Conceptual skills:** Eg. learning to read, count, tell the time, and use money.
- **Social skills:** Eg. the ability to follow social norms and rules and use manners.
- **Practical skills:** Eg. the ability to use money, travel, and use the telephone.

EXAMPLES

- **Tying shoes (Practical skill):**
Learning to put on their shoes and coat all by themselves.
- **Counting (Conceptual skill):**
Learning to count to at least 20 and understand what "greater than" and "lesser than" means.
- **Asking permission (Social skill):**
One student asks another if they can borrow their eraser instead of grabbing it.
